

BLOOD GLUCOSE CURVE WORKSHEET

Thank you for taking the time to perform this blood glucose curve at home.

This will help your veterinary team see a more accurate representation of your pet's blood glucose without the stress of visiting the hospital.

Instructions:

- 1 Take a blood glucose measurement before feeding your pet and record the value and time in the worksheet.
- 2 Feed your pet the typical amount.
- 3 Administer insulin as directed by your veterinarian.
- 4 Obtain blood glucose readings as directed by your veterinarian. It is typical to get a reading every 2-4 hours but this may differ from your veterinarian's recommendation for your pet.
- 5 Fill in the time you took the reading and the glucose measurement.
- 6 Submit to your veterinarian for evaluation. Never make insulin adjustments without consulting your veterinarian.
